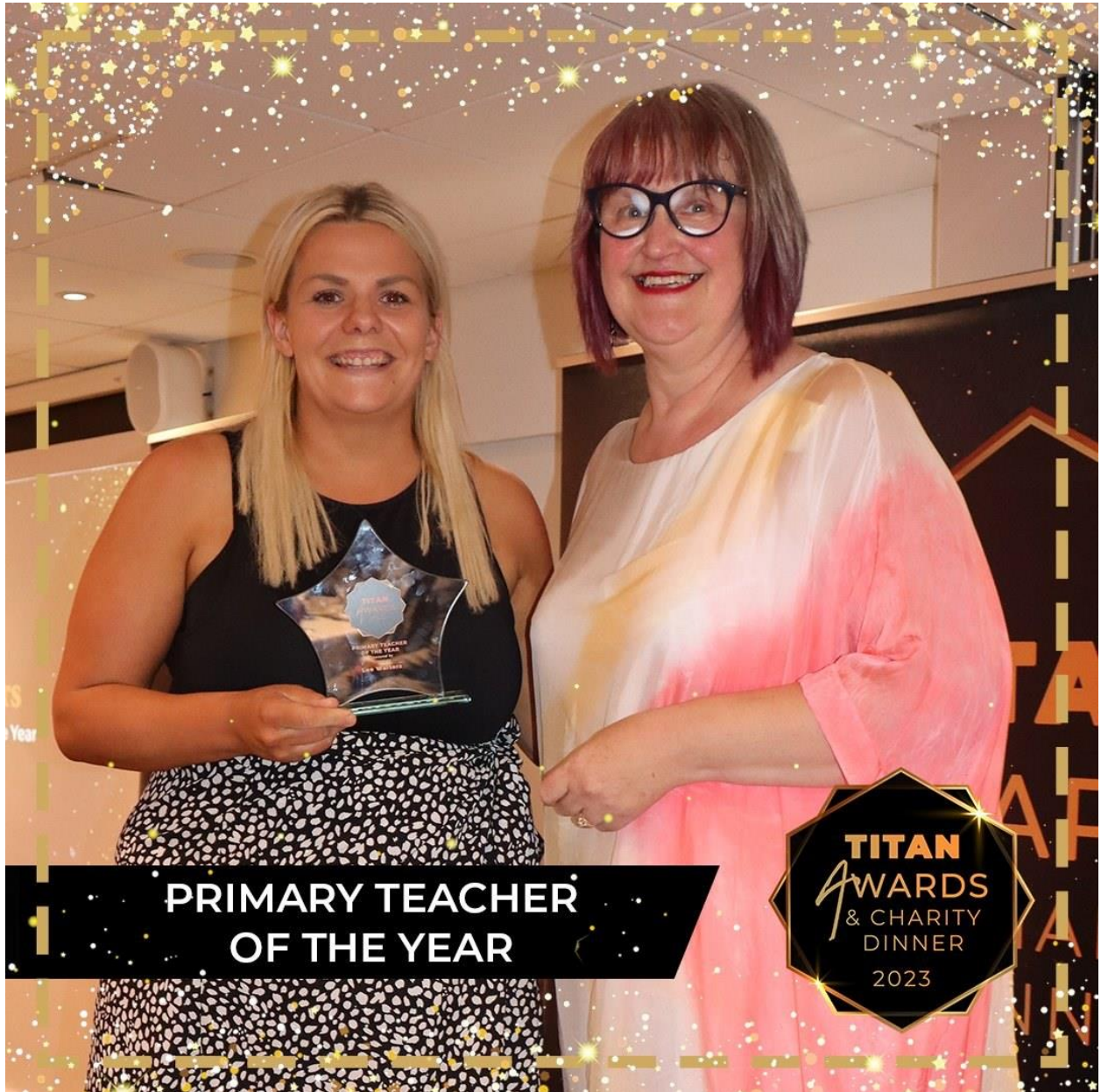
*The last day of school for pupils this term is Friday 21st July. The new academic year for pupils starts on Wednesday 6th September.*
